## **PLACES AND THEATRES OF WAR SERVED IN**

### **Pre-World War I (India and Overseas)**

**Aurangabad, India (1906–1908), Ceylon (now Sri Lanka), (1908–1911), Saugor, India (1911–1914).**

### **Theatres Served In During World War I**

- 1. Western Front (France) Sept 1914- Dec 1916. As part of Dehra Dun Brigade, 7 Meerut Division, Indian Corps of Indian Expeditionary Force 'A' sent to reinforce the British Expeditionary Force (BEF) fighting in France. Saw action in the Battles of La Bassée, 10 October–02 November 1914, Battle of Neuve Chappelle and subsequent actions 10 March - 22 April 1915, Battles of Ypres 1915 ("Second Ypres") 22 April - 25 May 1915.**
- 2. Mesopotamia (now Iraq) May 1917- Dec 1917. As part of Dehra Dun Brigade, 7 Meerut Division was de-inducted from France and arrived in Mesopotamia in May 1917 and joined Tigris Corps. The division participated in the battles at the Sheikh Sa'ad, Wadi, Hanna, Dujailia, and the Sannaiyat .Later formed part of the newly formed Mesopotamian Expeditionary Force, participating in the capture of Baghdad .**
- 3. Egypt and Palestine Dec 1917-June 1918. As part of the Egyptian Expeditionary force, Dehra Dun Brigade, 7 Meerut Division after the capture of Jerusalem, captured 'North Sister' and 'South Sister' Hills on 8 June, and raided 'Piffer Ridge' on 27 June. It subsequently took part in Allenby's advance through Palestine, including the Battle of Megiddo as part of Lieutenant-General Bulfin's XXI British Corps .**
- 3. Persia (Iran) Jan 1918. Part of East Persian Cordon Force and located at Kwash, Mashad, Turbat and Juzak.**

### **Post World War I (India)**

**Ferozpur, North West Frontier Province (Quetta, Sibi, Waziristan 1918-21 and Mahsud 1919-20, ) Iraq (Basra 1926- 28), Allahabad(1928-33)**
